Differentiation Statement for GateHouse Transitional Living

GateHouse Transitional Living provides long-term recovery housing options at eight different locations, throughout Lancaster, PA which is an enriched recovering community. Each transitional home is certified through the Pennsylvania Alliance of Recovery Residencies.

GateHouse Transitional Living rents are as low as \$126 per week, which includes basic toiletries, cleaning supplies, and some food items.

GateHouse Transitional Living offers our residents in early recovery support and structure, two valuable components that position them for long-term success. Each of the homes have a live-in house manager who oversees daily operations and provides support for each client residing in the home. Residents residing at GateHouse Transitional Living can receive their therapeutic services at GateHouse Behavioral Health Services. These services include, outpatient counseling, intensive outpatient, drug and alcohol evaluations, and partial hospitalization. In addition to the therapeutic services, GateHouse Transitional Living residents receive case management services on an as needed basis.

GateHouse Transitional Living supports the proven method of recovery related to the 12-step philosophy (asam.org) and empowers clients to obtain support and sponsorship by attending recovery meetings regularly. Residents are encouraged to maintain their personal recovery, employment, daily chores and attend all therapeutic appointments. This daily structure, along with the curfew, provides our residents with the tools to sustain long-term recovery. Residents residing at GateHouse Transitional Living are eligible for a weekend pass following thirty days of residency, and two weekend passes per month after 90 days.

GateHouse Transitional Living accepts scholarships from Perform Care and Community Care Behavioral Health. Providers making referrals to GateHouse Transitional Living can apply for this financial assistance on behalf of clients who are eligible.
